## Editorial Statement <u>REYDAMS-SCHILS, Gretchen</u>, *in 4. Plato 4 (2004)*, [En ligne], March 2004

Issue Four presents an article-length contribution, by Marlis Colloud-Streit, on the absence of a myth in the Sophist. This contribution is followed by a collection of six shorter papers that reflect on the theme 'Platonic Knowledge: Is it an Illusion?' These papers, by Luc Brisson, Michael Erler, Christopher Gill, Lloyd Gerson, Noburu Notomi, and Samual Scolnicov, were presented together at the World Congress of Philosophy at Istanbul, in August 2003. They provide a synoptic view of many key epistemological questions, and, in some cases, give access to recently published scholarly analyses. The issue closes with three reviews, by Luc Brisson, Eduardo Mombello and Mario Vegetti.

Platonic scholars can take up the opportunity to use this journal as a means of reaching a truly world-wide scholarly audience. Articles so published have a distinct publication home (the URL of the journal) and remain in the copyright of the contributor. The journal is especially suitable for shorter papers (up to 4,000 words) in which new ideas about Plato, the Platonic tradition or responses to Platonic scholarship can be communicated promptly to the larger academic community. All submissions are refereed (anonymously) by expert readers, including a native or fluent speaker of the language of the article. The next deadline for submission of contributions is end of September 2004.
