Dear Professor Henriques,

It was very good of you to go to the trouble of preparing a list of the plates of the Bol. Soc. Bot., but we have already abstracted them. Your offer to complete our quotations from Hoffmannsegg & Link, Fl. Portugal is extremely welcome as our copy is incomplete, the second volume ending with page 256 and plate 106 (*Athamantha ramosissima*) after which follow 4 planches d'Instruction in black and white. So if you would kindly supply the references to the missing plates we shall be very grateful indeed and if you do so would you mark those, if any, that are uncoloured.

I am afraid I owe you still a reply to an earlier letter concerning Gossweiler's grasses. A part of the Flora of Tropical Africa bringing the Paniceae up to *Setaria* will be published very soon and you will find there the determinations of Gossweiler's grasses as far as they belong to genera dealt with there. I have no list of determinations of these grasses beyond *Setaria*, but they will be gradually worked out and incorporated in the Fl. Trop. Afr. To name them in advance would entail much labour and identifications could only be preliminary. I might also add that the best set of Gossweiler's is not at Kew but at The British Museum.
